# Dublin Airport Update

- A total of 2.8 million passengers passed through the doors of Dublin Airport in October, which was 4% higher than in the same month last year.
- New appointments at daa - Gary McLean has been appointed to the role of Managing Director Dublin Airport. John Brennan will take up the new role of MD of daa Labs, the new IT and innovation department for daa groups, and Peter Dunne has been appointed as the new Chief Financial Officer for daa.
- Essential maintenance works took place last week from Monday, November 6 to November 9 (originally scheduled until November 10). These maintenance works were extended from 9pm to 5am to allow for the regular essential maintenance works and essential pavement repair works on one of our most heavily used taxiways rather than two separate works.
- Community Fund closed with over 75 applications received, the biggest round to date. The Independent Grant Making Panel will meet in mid-December after which we will advise on the success of the applications.
- Next year's suggested CLG meeting dates – January 23, March 12, May 14, July 16, September 10, November 26.





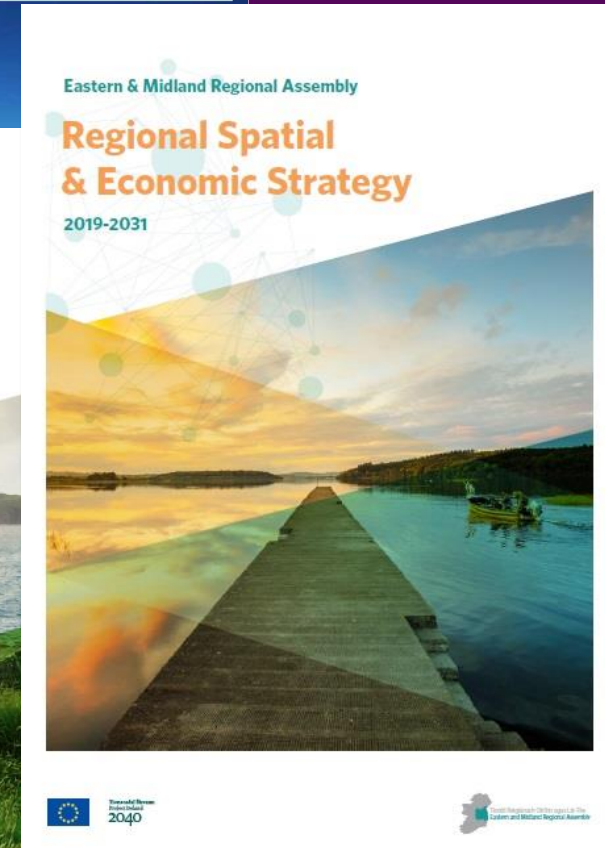
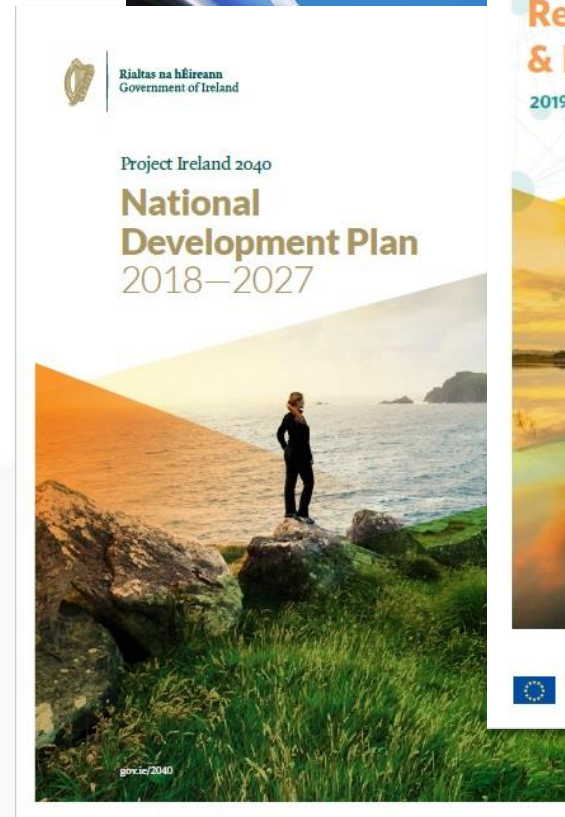
# Proposed Infrastructure Application

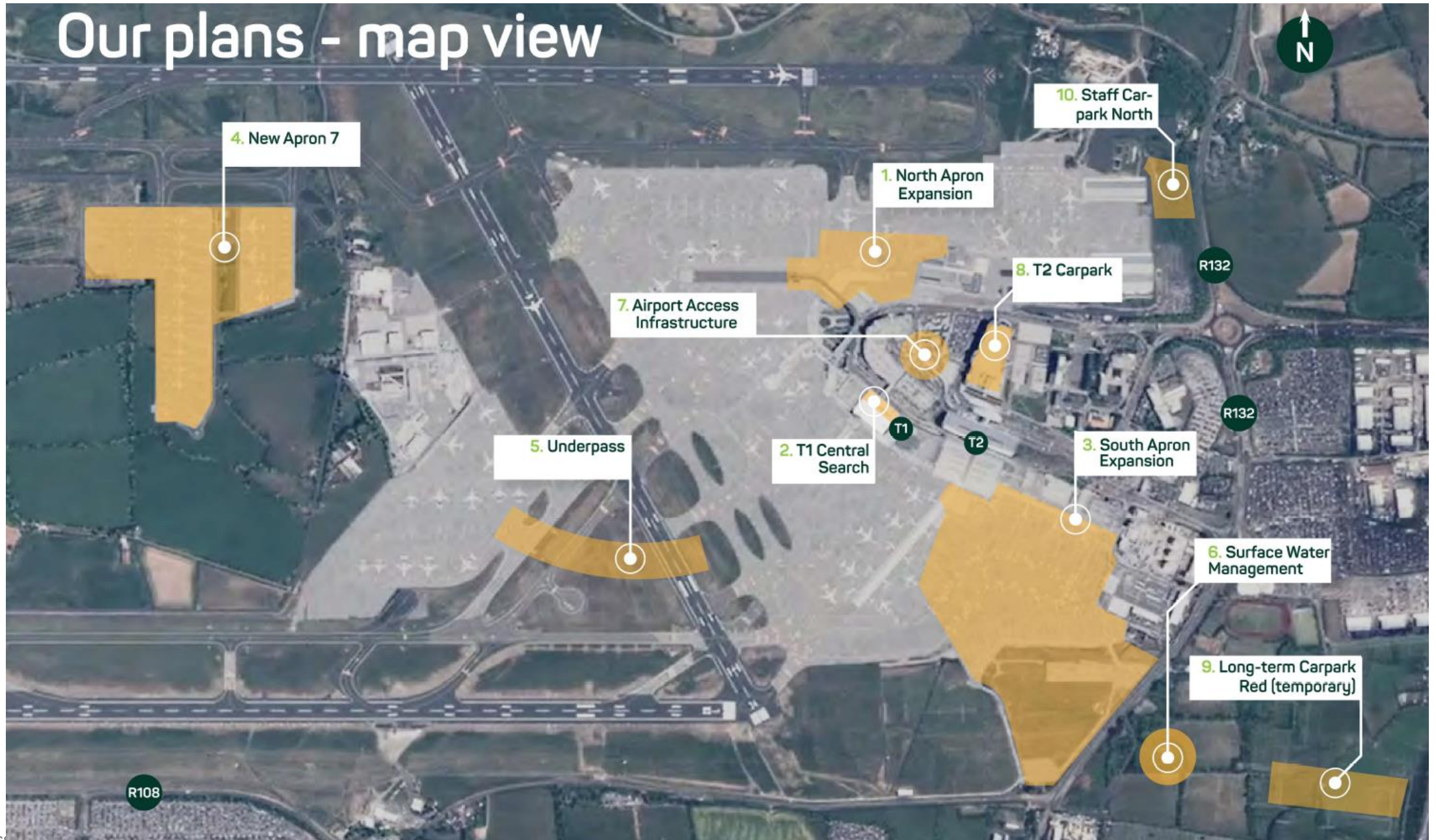

- To support this the application will include a series of infrastructure elements which provide capacity while ensuring the provisions of an improved level of passenger experience
- It is intended to submit the application later this year

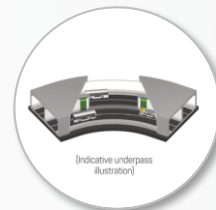

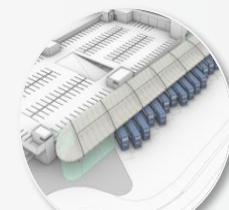
