Dublin Airport Update

- Over 3.2 million passengers passed through Dublin Airport in June. Around 1.95 million passengers (61%) passed through Terminal 1 during June, with 1.25 million going through Terminal 2.
- North Runway's next phase of operational integration moved to the permitted hours of 7am to 11pm from July 4, 2023.
- The South Runway was withdrawn from service to facilitate essential maintenance works from 11.00pm to 4.30am for two nights last week; works were unable to continue due to inclement weather. These works have been rescheduled to this week from Tuesday July 18 to Friday, July 21.
- There has been a strong response to the insulation letters that issued in early May to residents who are eligible for the Residential Noise Insulation Scheme.
- To facilitate road surfacing works, expected traffic management will take place on the R108 from end August. Full information including the schedule of works will be circulated to members in advance.
- Community Fund Round 12 was a bumper round of applications with over 250k awarded to nearly 60 groups in the local communities. The next round will open in September for applications.
