Executive Summary

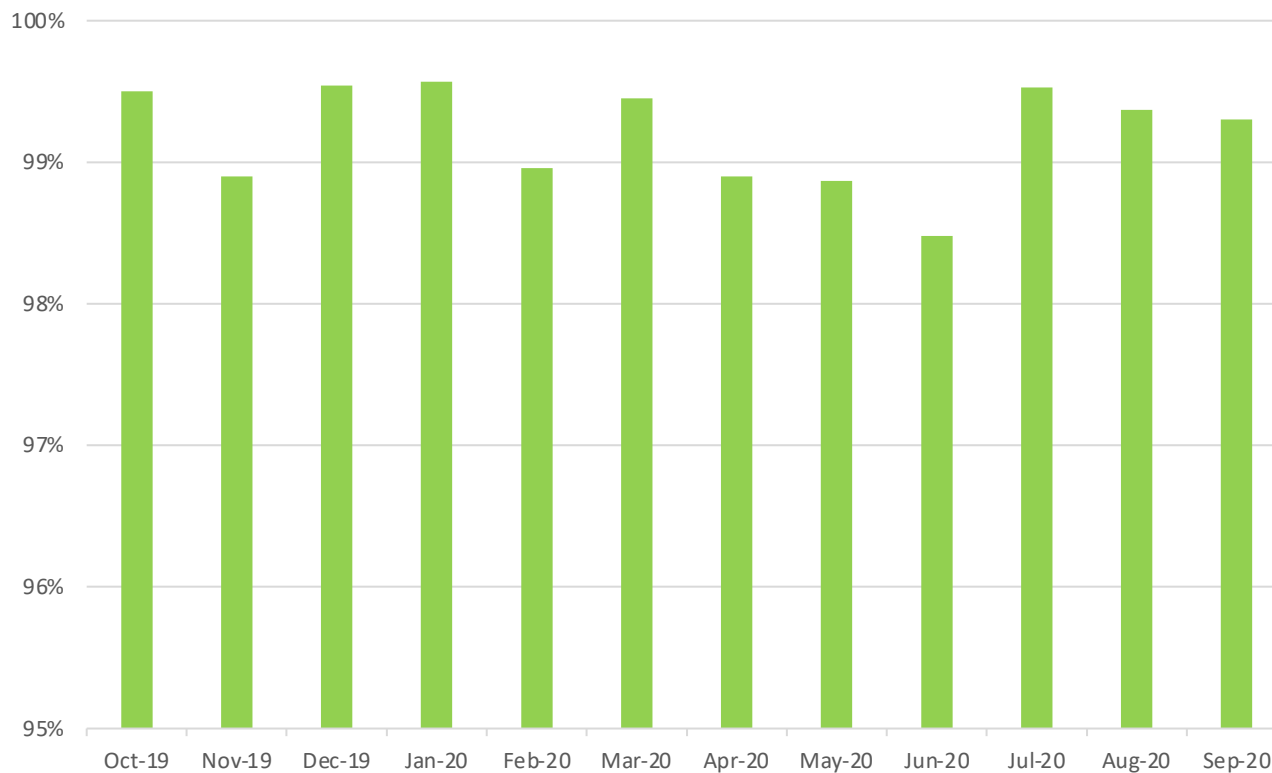
Aircraft Compliance with approved flight routings:

- Just over 99.3% of Category C/D aircraft flew on track during the month.

Noise Complaints:

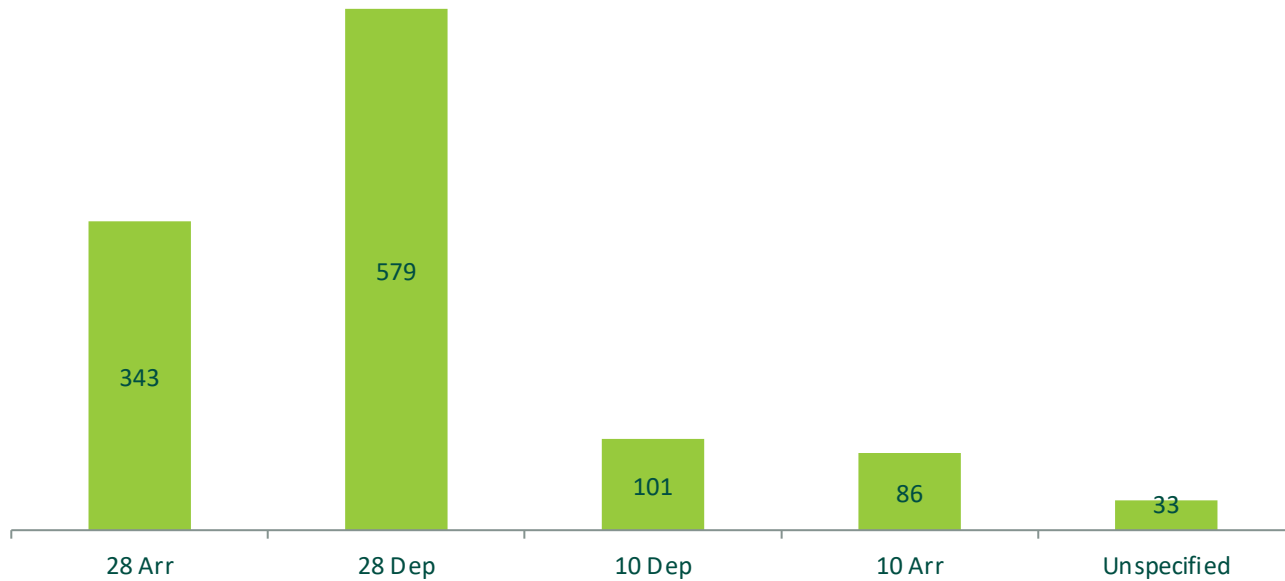
- In September, 1144 noise complaints were received by Dublin Airport. Included in this number was 1 noise complaints for an aircraft that did not operate to or from Dublin Airport and another which was not related to aircraft noise.
- Excluding these complaints there was a total for Dublin Airport of 1142 noise complaints received from 14 individual complainants.
- One individual complainant lodged 1050 complaints (92% of Dublin Airports total). No proximate aircraft event could be identified for 451 of these (approx. 43% of total). Another complainant lodged 61 complaints which was 5.3% of Dublin Airports total. These two complainants were responsible for lodging over 97% of the total complaints for the month.

Category C/D Aircraft On Track Performance (Rolling 12 Months)

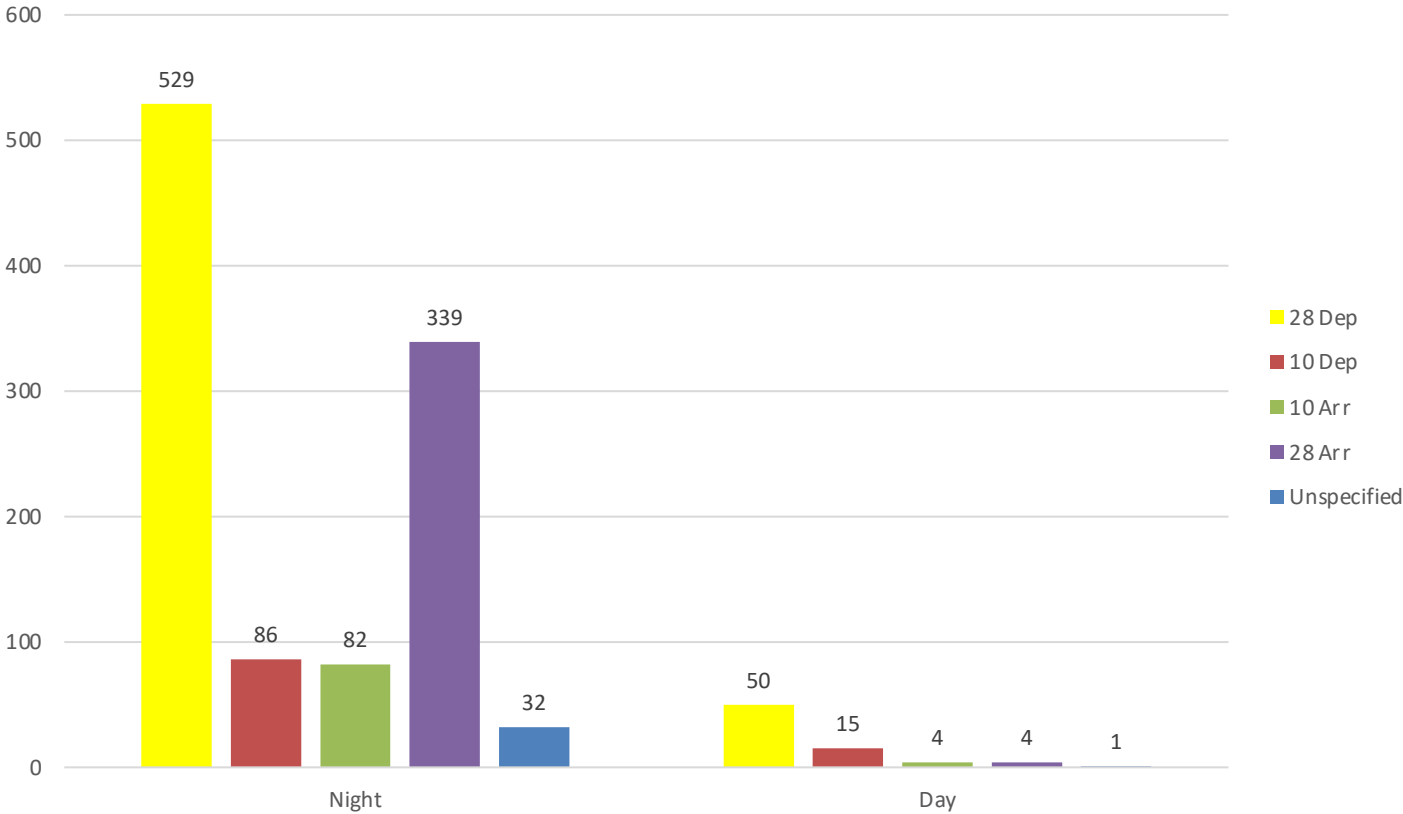


Category C/D Aircraft include all jet aircraft excluding BAE146 type aircraft.

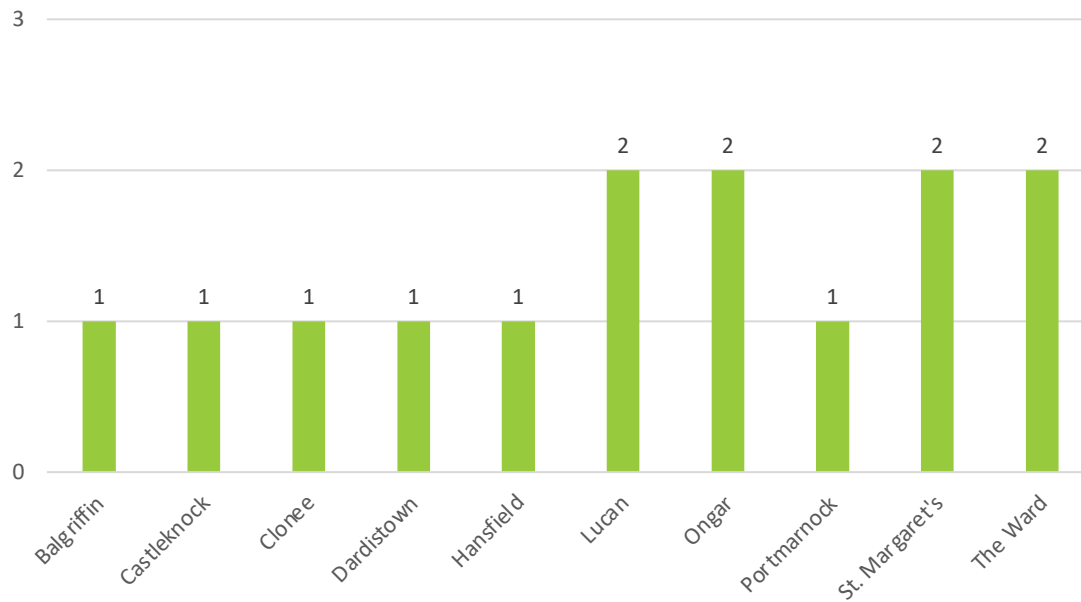
Noise Complaint Analysis By Runway September 2020



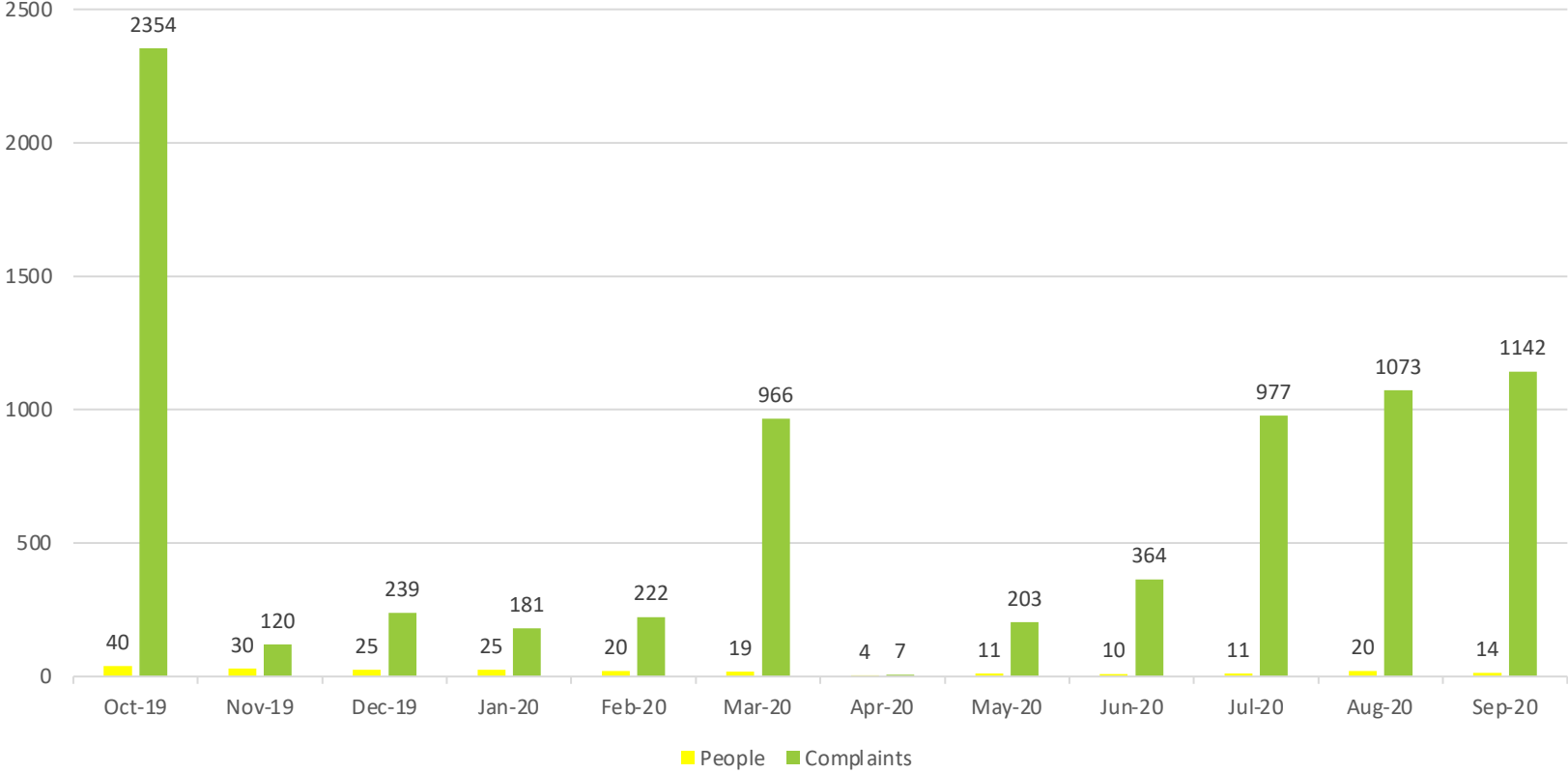
Day / Night Noise Complaints By Runway September 2020



Complainant Analysis By Area September 2020

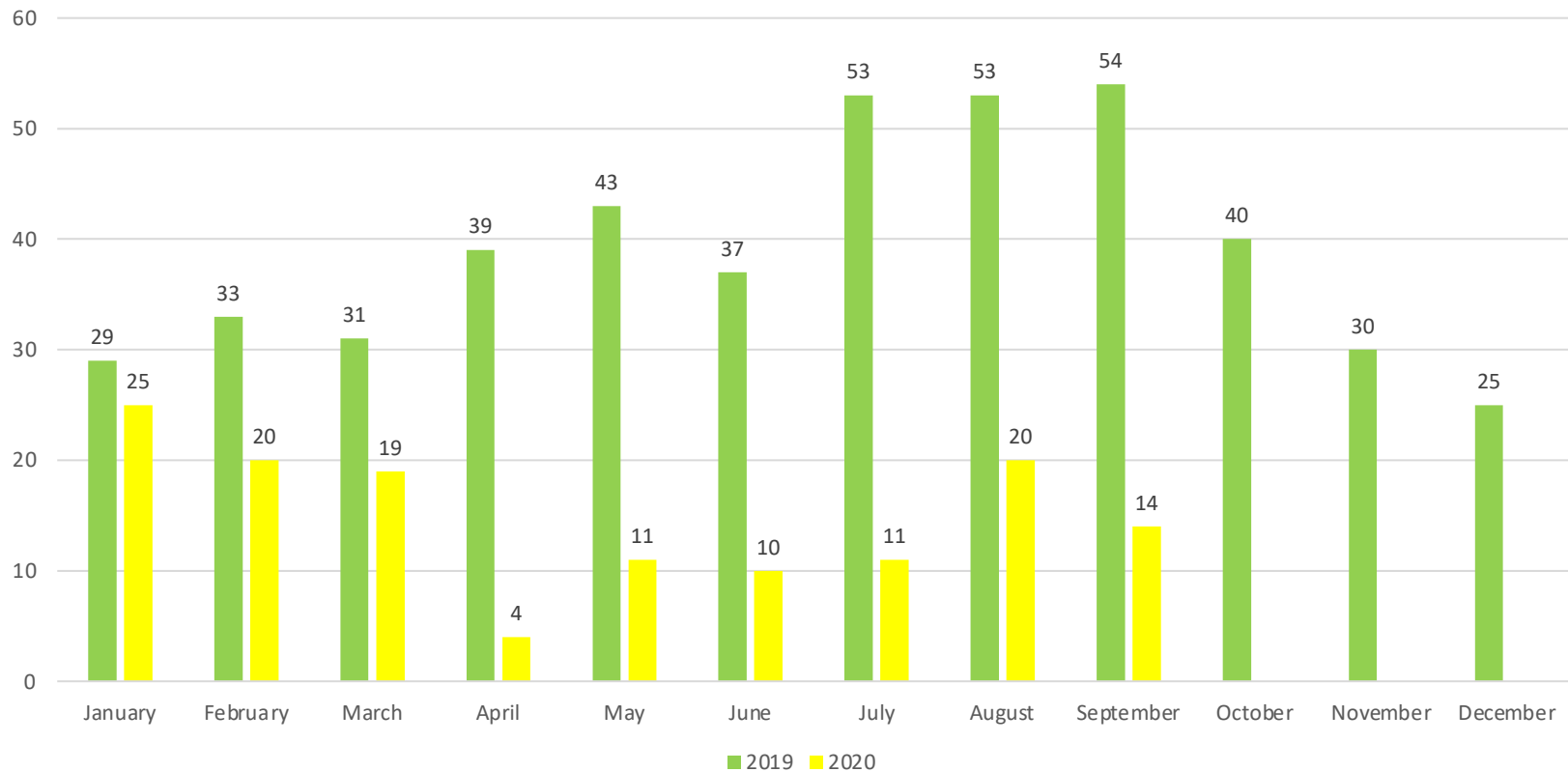


Noise Complaint Analysis Rolling 12 Months



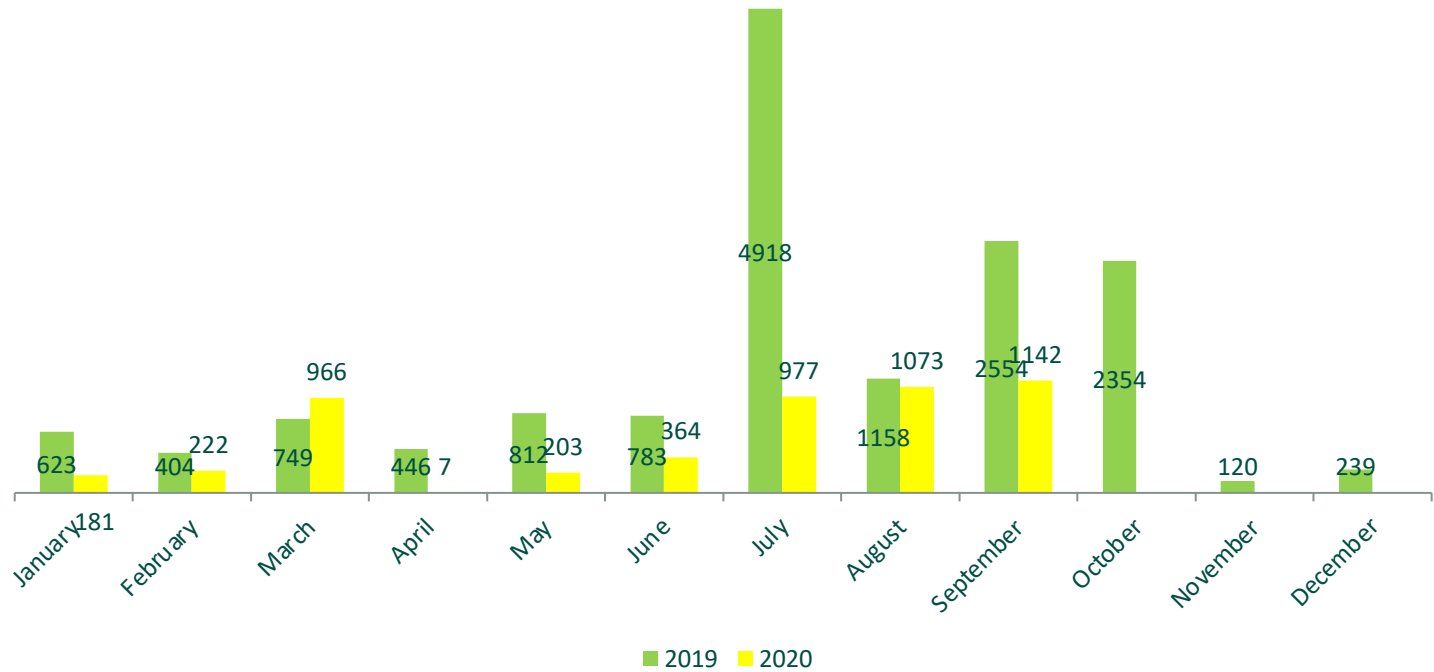
