Executive Summary

March 2022

Number of movements in March recorded in the NFTMS* system

- There were 15,336 movements in March associated with Dublin airport. Of those;
 - 7,662 were arriving aircraft
 - 7,670 were departing aircraft
 - 4 were Touch and Go (Training) flights

Aircraft Compliance with approved flight routings:

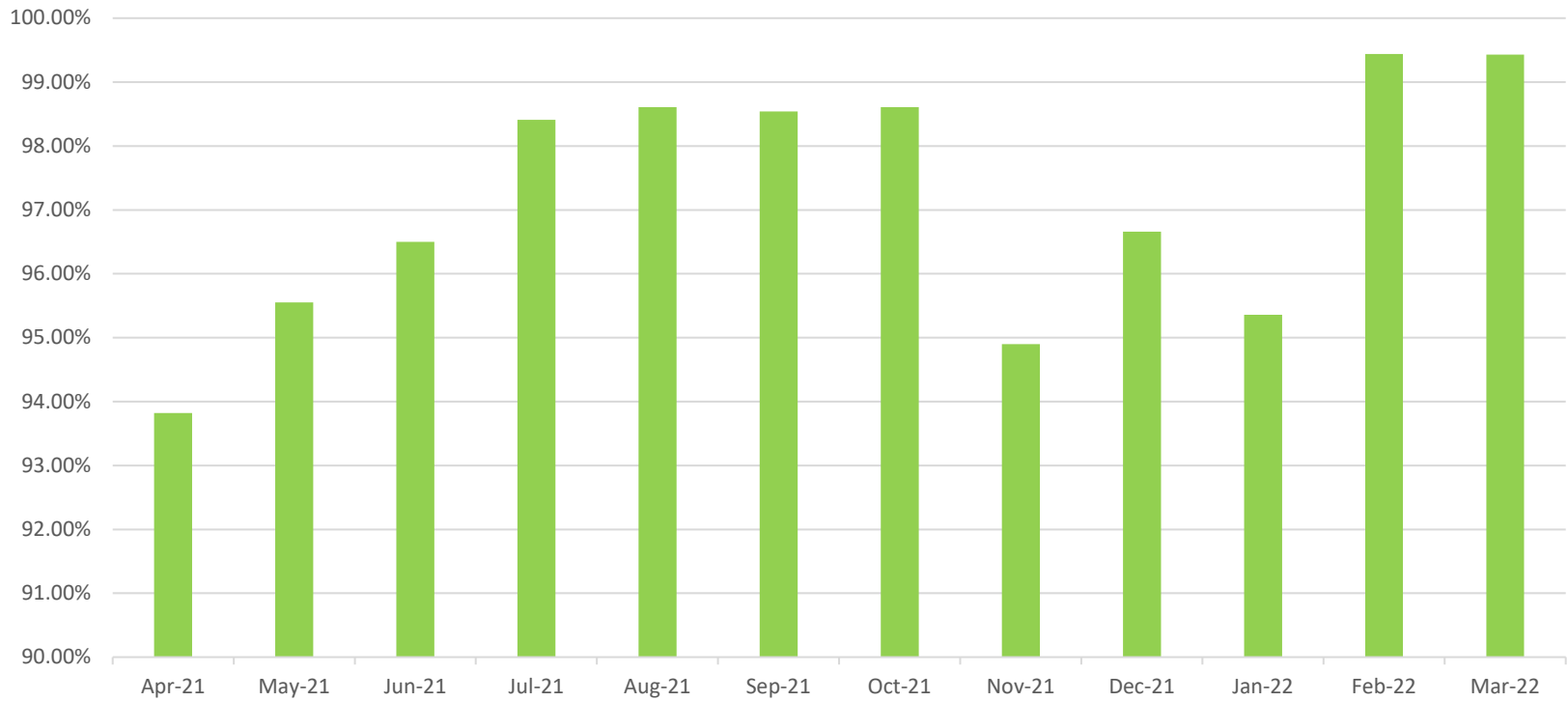
- Just over 99% of Category C/D aircraft flew on track during the month.

Noise Complaints:

- In March, there were 1,983 noise complaints received from 45 individuals by Dublin Airport.
- One individual complainant lodged 1,883 complaints (95% of Dublin Airports total)

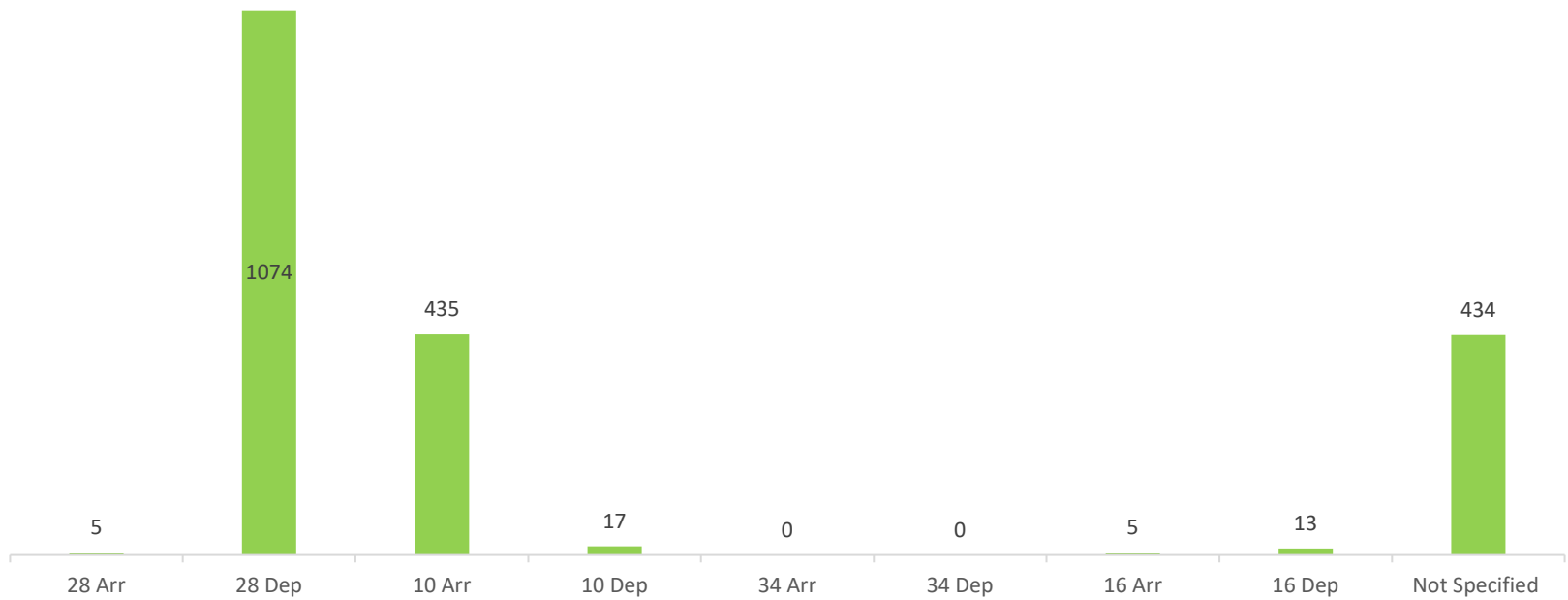

Category C/D Aircraft On Track Performance (Rolling 12 Months)

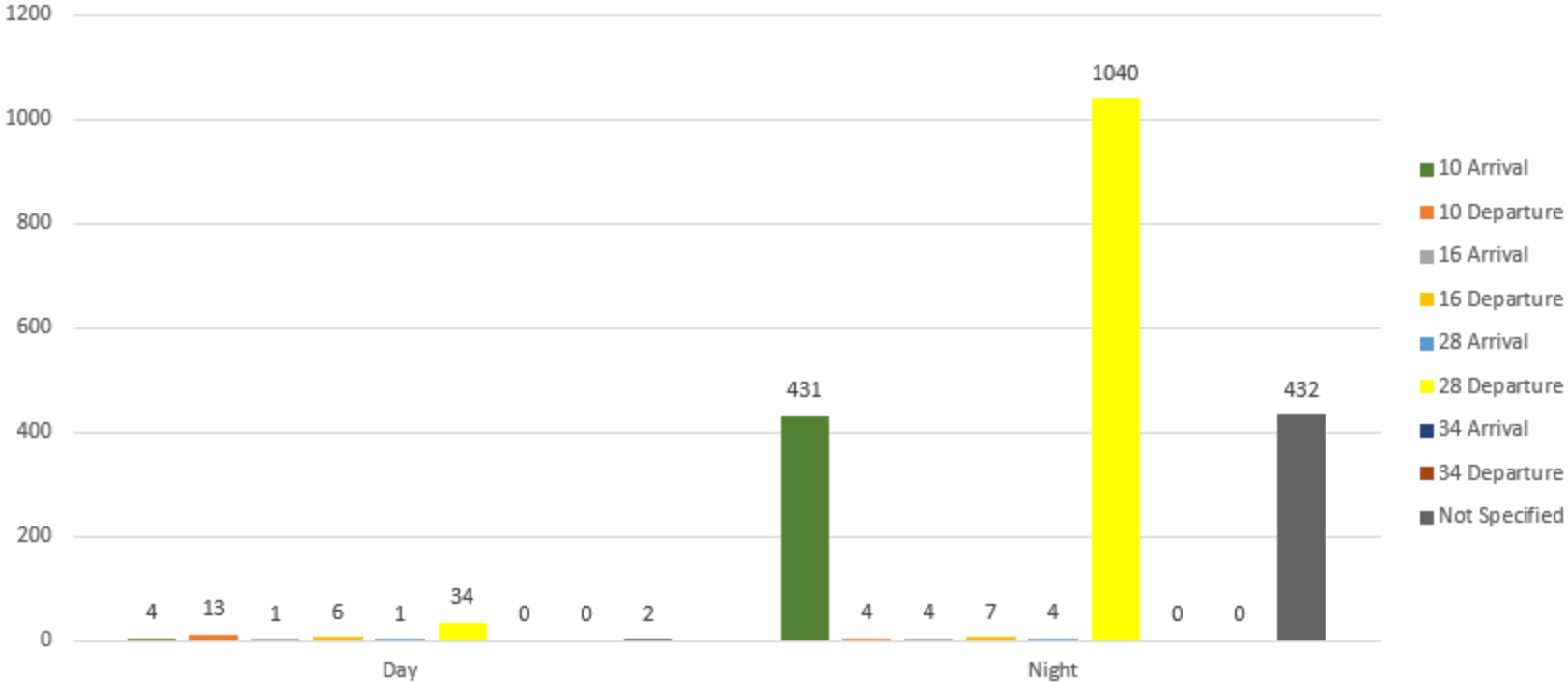


CAT C/D includes all Jet aircraft excluding BAE146 type aircraft

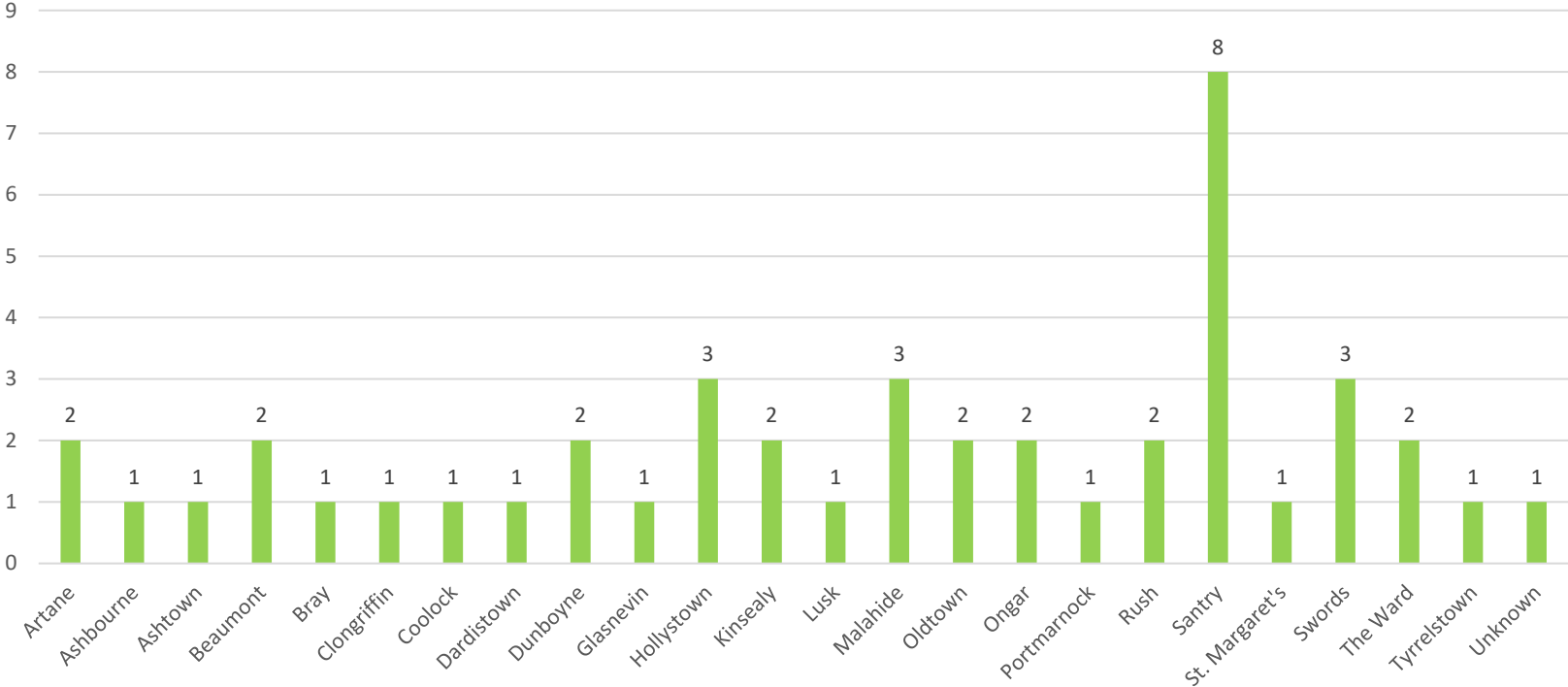
Noise Complaint Analysis By Runway March 2022



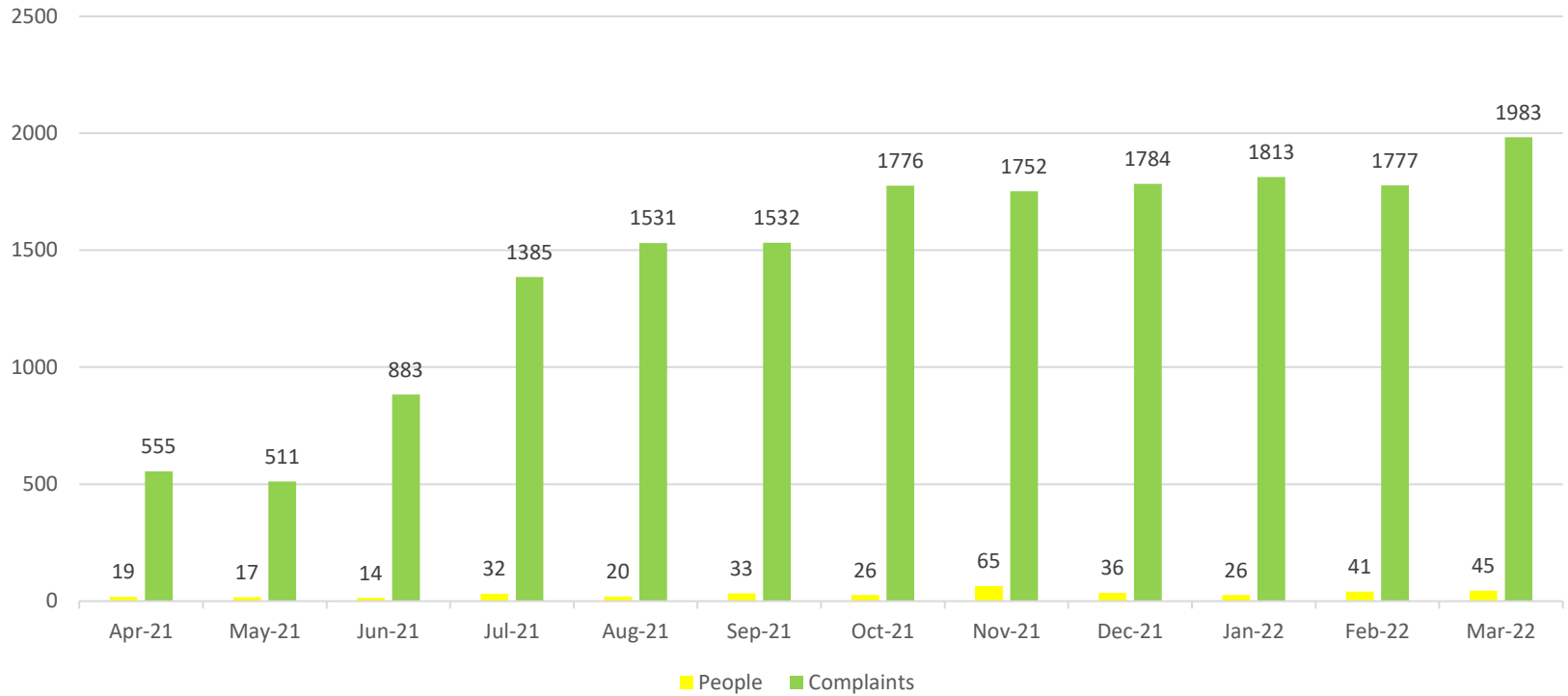
Day / Night Noise Complaints By Runway March 2022



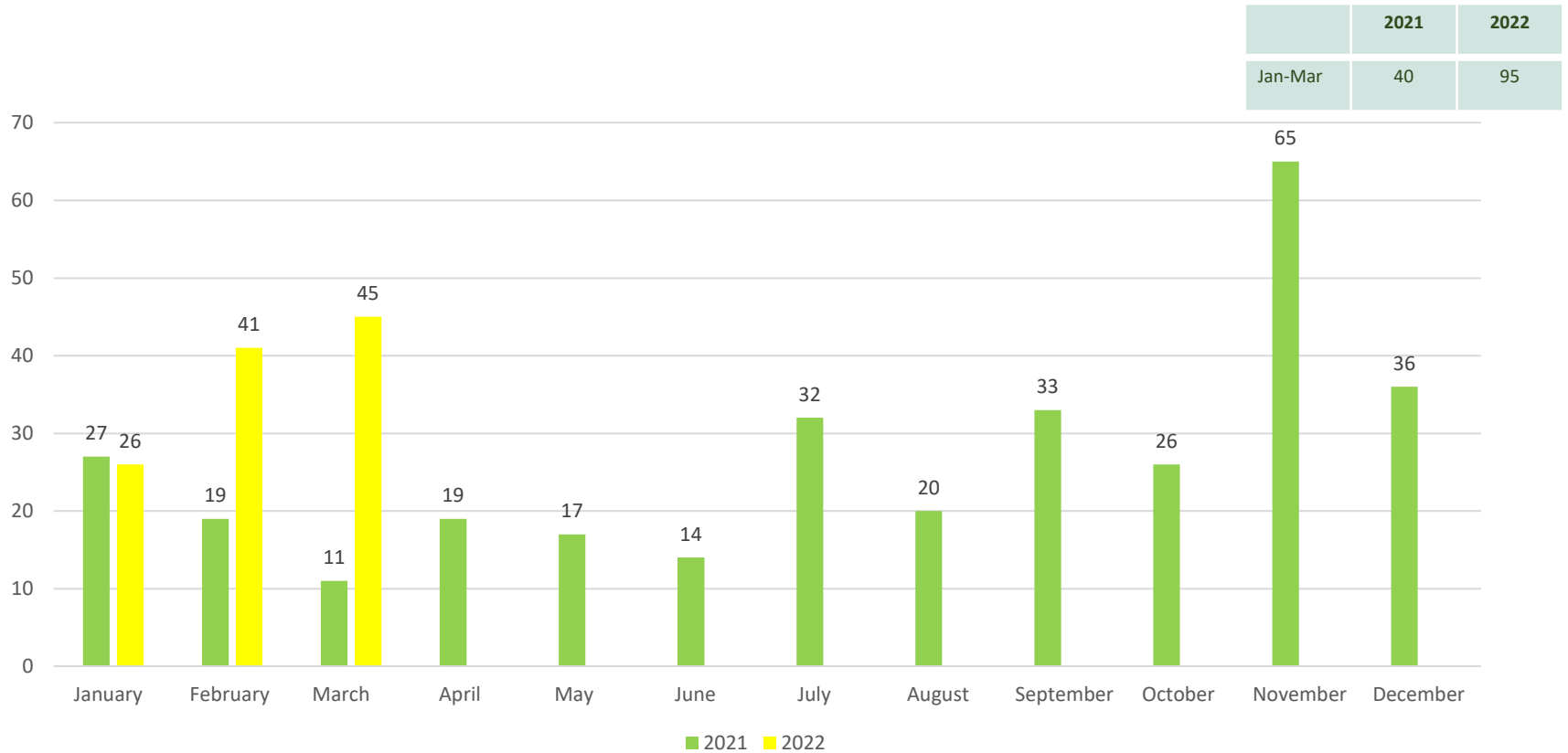
Complainant Analysis By Area March 2022



Noise Complaint Analysis Rolling 12 Months



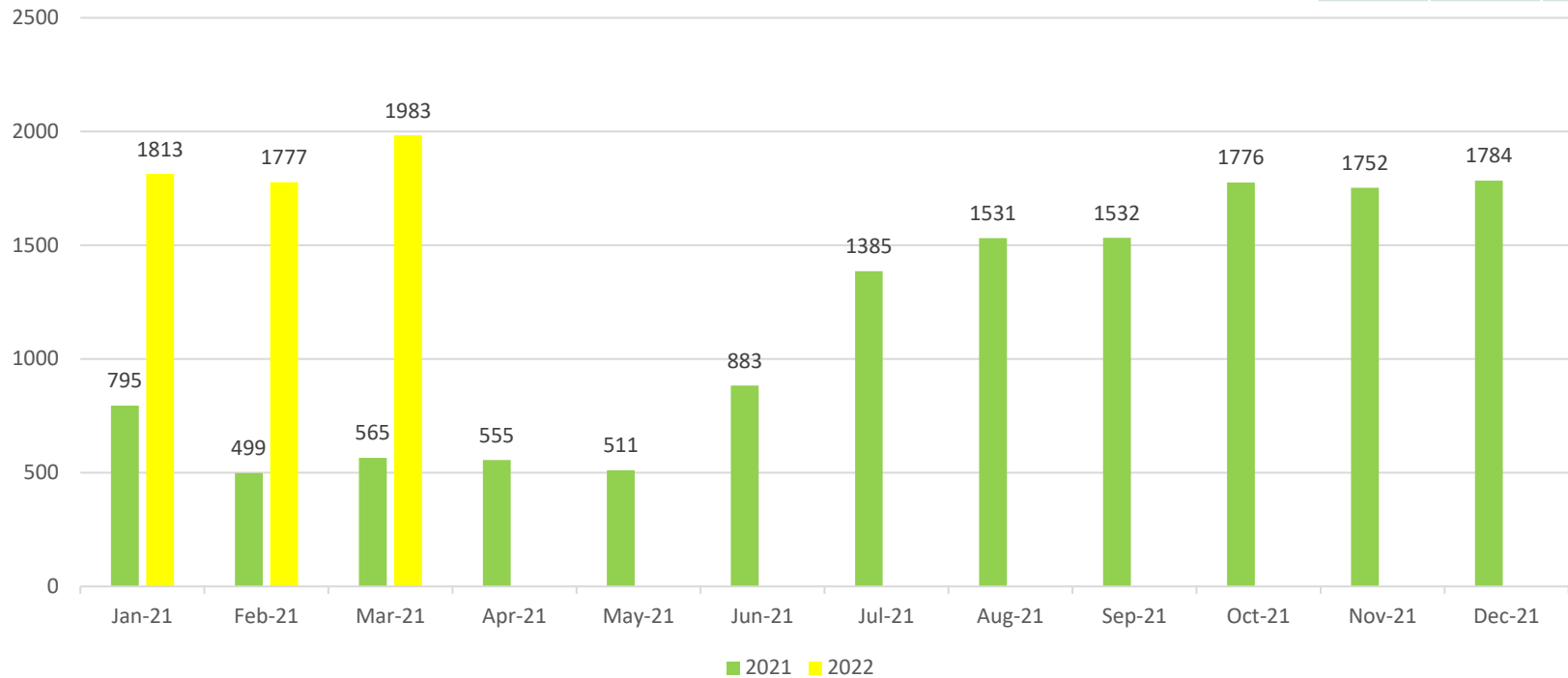

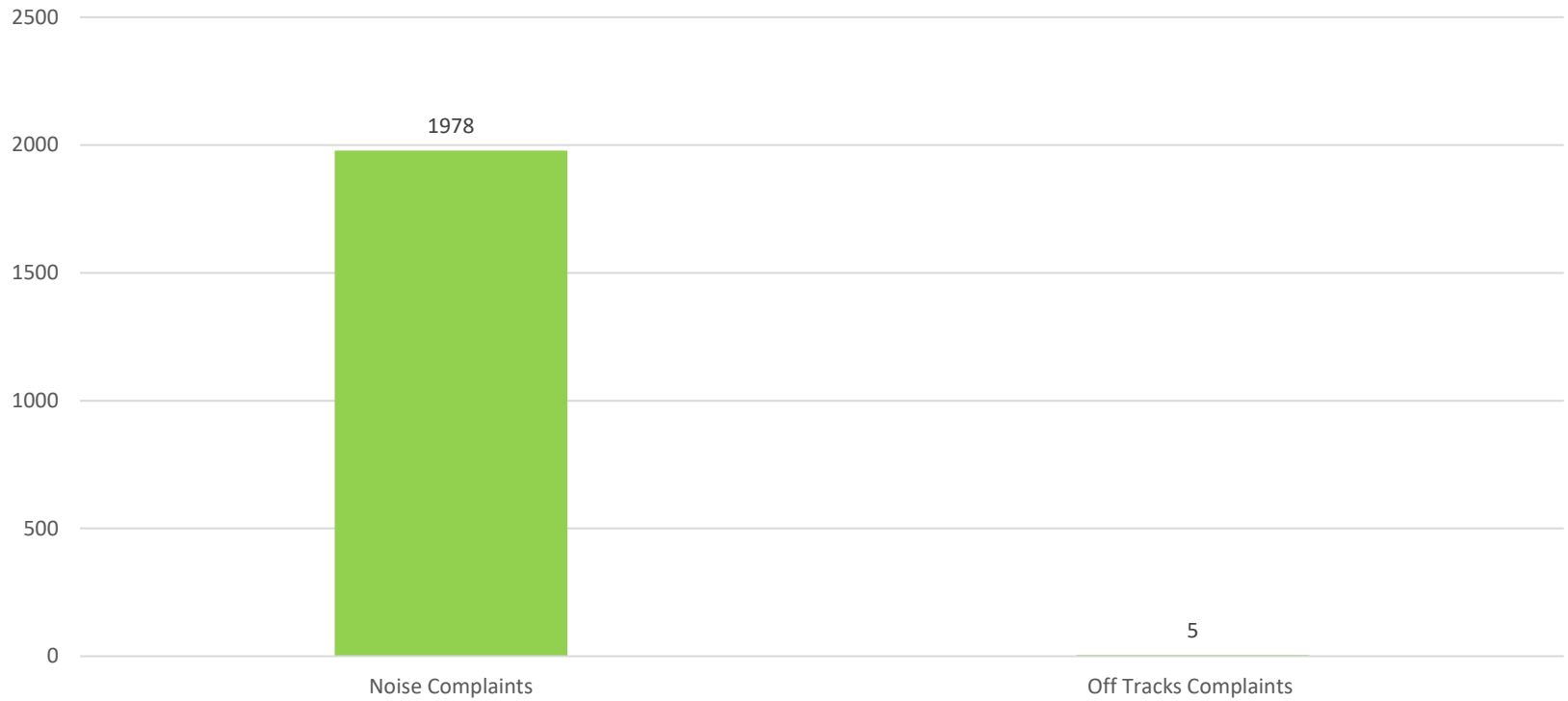
