4. FCC Update – presented by Matthew McAleese	Action Owner
MMA advised that there were no actions from the previous meeting MMA provided an update on the draft Fingal Development Plan advising it went on display on 24 February, and the last day for submissions is 12 May 2022.	
5. daa Update – presented by Michelle Molloy	Action Owner
MM presented daa’s update including the actions from the previous meeting, Dublin Airport’s update including easing of Covid restrictions, passenger numbers, Community Fund and North Runway. MG asked if daa could drop leaflets regarding North Runway’s opening to residents in the immediate vicinity of Dublin Airport. MM confirmed this would take place for St. Margaret’s, The Ward and rural locations.	daa
6. Noise Monitoring Terminals Update – Ciaran Moore and Ian Clarke	
CM and ICL gave updates on Complaint statistics for January 2022, WebTrak, Annual Noise Report and the proposed locations of additional Noise Monitoring Terminals (NMTs). ICL thanked the members for their suggested locations for the NMTs. He advised that a fixed NMT will be placed at St. Margaret’s National School and a mobile NMT will be placed, in rotation, at Newtown, Millhead, Dunsoghly and The Ward Cross. MG asked how long the mobile NMT will be at each location, and ICL advised for a 12-month period. CM gave an overview of the noise monitoring data and MG requested further information regarding aircraft violating the environmental noise corridor. IC also requested a high resolution copy of the map contained in the NFTM presentation.	daa
7. Residents Update	Action Owner
LOG gave an update on Professor Munzel’s presentation, and requested that the link to the video, presentation and biography be sent to members by the Secretariat.	daa
8. Dublin Airport Planning Applications	Action Owner
MMA advised the planning list was circulated on 2 March which contained information on a total of 13 applications. LOG noted the newly-approved drop off and collection point charge. MM explained that the approach addresses the congestion issue and that an alternative free drop off and collection point would be available with a free, regular bus shuttle service to bring passengers to the terminal. RF stated that the St. Margaret’s community has no public	



bus service and because they are most impacted by airport operations, drop-off/collection should be free of charge for local residents.
