daa Actions from Previous Meetings and Subsequent Requests

No	Action	daa Response
1.	daa to consider the installation of a temporary noise monitor at Dunbro Lane	Presently there are 9 noise monitoring stations in the vicinity of the airport strategically located under flight paths. Noise monitoring reports are produced on a 6 monthly basis and are available on our website. The noise reporting and complaints process is under review at present and additional noise monitors may be considered in light of that.
2.	daa to consider revisiting noxious weeds on daa lands	Weeds have been addressed.
3.	daa to follow up on the replacement of gates on Dukes Farm	Replacement gates will be fitted at this location. Date to be confirmed.

North Runway Update

- Issued Statements of Need to Phase 1 Insulation Schemes eligible residents
- Insulation Information Days took place on the 3rd and 11th September
- Positive response to scheme
- Letters to Phase 2 eligible residents have issued regarding the appointment of the consultant and scheduling of surveys in Q4
- Consultation underway with planning authorities regarding the layout of the runway, following the introduction of new European Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) standards



Dublin Airport Update

- Aer Lingus have launched new direct services to Minneapolis-St. Paul, Minnesota and Montreal, Canada next summer
- American Airlines' announced that it is to operate a new Dublin-Dallas Fort Worth summer service from June 2019
- Dublin Airport has opened a new €16 million transfer facility designed specifically for passengers who are transferring from one flight to another and will greatly enhance Dublin Airport's ability to compete for transfer traffic between Europe and North America
- The Community Fund is open for applications until Monday October 15th and we would encourage submissions from eligible areas
- The next Dublin Airport Drop In Information Clinic is on the 27th September The Riasc Centre, Feltrim Road, Swords, 3pm to 6.30pm
- We're taking part in Culture Night tomorrow with talks on Dublin Airport's history, a live performance by Comhaltas Ceoltóirí Éireann Port Mearnóg and installations that from part of the airport's Creative Journey's partnership with the National College of Art and Design (NCAD)
