Dublin Airport's aeronautical charges remain the lowest of any capital city airport in Europe

There are variety of incentive schemes available to new and existing airlines operating at Dublin Airport, including the the Low Emissions Aircraft Discount scheme (LEAD) introduced for 2024.

This scheme incentivises airlines to operate quieter, cleaner and more fuel efficient aircraft at Dublin Airport.

Under this **scheme**, a 12.5% discount is applied to the Passenger Service charge and Runway Movement Charge for qualifying aircraft.

Preparing for Ireland's future



At Dublin Airport, the growth and development of your business is important.

That's why the airport is constantly evolving, with a new runway in operation, world-class connectivity and U.S. Pre-clearance, Dublin Airport is Ireland's gateway to the world.

SECURITY:

Dublin Airport has introduced C3 security scanners for quicker security checks. These C3 scanners replace the traditional baggage x-ray machines with no need to remove liquids and electronics.

ADDITIONAL RUNWAY:

Dublin Airport opened its new North Runway in 2022, which facilitates larger aircraft and connectivity with long-haul destinations.

BAGGAGE:

An installation of a €200 million integrated baggage handling system was rolled out at Dublin Airport in 2023, future-proofing the system for up to 40 million passengers per annum at Dublin Airport.

VIRTUAL INFORMATION ROOM:

daa has launched a new virtual information room to highlight the wide range of improvements planned for Dublin Airport as part of its planning application to Fingal County Council, which will enable the airport to grow to 40 million passengers per year.
