• From 23rd Feb 2023, this report refers to all complaints concerning their operations at Dublin Airport.

Executive Summary February 2023

Number of movements in February recorded in the NFTMS* system

- There were 12,392 movements in February associated with Dublin airport. Of those;
 - 7,424 were arriving aircraft
 - 4,967 were departing aircraft
 - 1 were Touch and Go (Training) flights

Aircraft Compliance with approved flight routings:

• Just over 98% of Category C/D aircraft flew on track during the month.

Noise Complaints:

- In February, there were 1,876 noise complaints received from 176 individuals by Dublin Airport.
- One individual complainant lodged 1,329 complaints. (71% of Dublin Airports total)


Number of Track Violations:

• There were 48 track violations during the month of February.





Category C/D Aircraft On Track Performance (Rolling 12 Months)






Noise Complaint Analysis By Runway February 2023






Day / Night Noise Complaints By Runway February 2023






Complainant Analysis By Area with largest number of complainants - Feb 2023





Noise Complaint Analysis Rolling 12 Months






Track Violations Analysis Rolling 12 Months from February 2023






Individual Complainant Analysis 2022 V 2023



This is the number of unique individual complainants during the reporting period



Noise Complaints Analysis 2022 V 2023






Noise Complaints Versus Off Track Complaints February 2023






Noise Event Type Analysis By Runway February 2023
