# Executive Summary March 2023

### Number of movements in March recorded in the NFTMS\* system

- There were 18,386 movements in March associated with Dublin airport. Of those;
  - 9,183 were arriving aircraft
  - 9,199 were departing aircraft
  - 4 were Touch and Go (Training) flights

### Aircraft Compliance with approved flight routings:

Just over 95% of Category C/D aircraft flew on track during the month.

#### **Noise Complaints:**

- In March, there were 3,226 noise complaints received from 234 individuals by Dublin Airport.
- One individual complainant lodged 2,110 complaints. (65% of Dublin Airports total)


#### **Number of Track Violations:**

There were 368 track violations during the month of March.





## **Category C/D Aircraft On Track Performance (Rolling 12 Months)**






## Day / Night Noise Complaints By Runway March 2023










## **Noise Complaint Analysis Rolling 12 Months**






## **Track Violations Analysis Rolling 12 Months from February 2023**






## **Individual Complainant Analysis 2022 V 2023**






## Noise Complaints Analysis 2022 V 2023






## **Noise Complaints Versus Off Track Complaints March 2023**






### Noise Event Type Analysis By Runway March 2023
