• From 23rd Feb 2023, this report refers to all complaints concerning their operations at Dublin Airport.

Executive Summary October 2023

Number of movements in October recorded in the NFTMS* system

- There were 22,214 movements in October associated with Dublin airport. Of those;
 - 11,101 were arriving aircraft
 - 11,103 were departing aircraft
 - 10 were Touch and Go (Training) flights

Aircraft Compliance with approved flight routings:

• Just over 93% of Category C/D aircraft flew on track during the month.

Noise Complaints:

- In October, there were 2,514 noise complaints received from 305 individuals by Dublin Airport.
- One individual complainant lodged 102 complaints (4% of Dublin Airport's total).

Number of Track Violations:

There were 649 track violations during the month of October.





Category C/D Aircraft On Track Performance (Rolling 12 Months)






Noise Complaint Analysis By Runway October 2023






Day / Night Noise Complaints By Runway October 2023






Complainant Analysis By Area with largest number of complainants - Oct 2023




Noise Complaint Analysis Rolling 12 Months






Track Violations Analysis Rolling 12 Months from February 2023






Noise Complaints Versus Off Track Complaints October 2023






Noise Event Type Analysis By Runway October 2023
