Actions from Previous Meeting and Updates

Dublin Airport Update

- Just over 2.7 million passengers travelled through Dublin Airport in October, an increase of over 1.1 million passengers compared to the same month in 2021, and representing 94% of pre-pandemic passenger numbers in October 2019.
- Dublin Airport's Terminal 2 has welcomed over 100 million passengers since its opening on November 19 2010.
- In November, Dublin Airport hosted a jobs fair at the Radisson Blu Hotel which saw very large attendance across the two-day event.
- The independent Grant Making Panel met this week to review applications and agree support for the current round of Dublin Airport's Community Fund.
- It is proposed to commence installation of temporary noise monitors this week at four of the locations put forward by St. Margaret's and The Ward.
- The review of North Runway's flightpaths has resulted in proposed modifications to the current SIDs which are now under regulatory review, as detailed in email issued to CLG.
- Provisional 2023 dates for CLG meetings are Tuesdays, 7 February, 18 April, 30 May, 18 July, 5 September and 14 November, with alternating meetings in-person and online, subject to review.
