daa update

- daa welcomed 2.9 million passengers to Dublin Airport in April (up 7.5% on the same period last year).
- daa has gifted an eight-hectare compensatory habitat at Kilsallaghan to Fingal County Council (FCC). The habitat is designed to support a variety of native flora and fauna, providing a sanctuary for wildlife. This is effectively a "rewilded" area and FCC will provide managed and supervised access to the site by arrangement.
- Dublin Airport launched 'Insightfull' a new online tool that provides interactive information about flights to and from the airport, with associated location-specific noise data. This technology was developed by Envirosuite, a global leader in environmental intelligence solutions and is used at more than 25 airports worldwide, including Gatwick and Toronto Preston.
- Later this month, as part of its 85th birthday celebrations, Dublin Airport will launch '*Elevate '25*', a special one-off school support programme that will be available to local primary and secondary schools.










Water Monitoring Locations
