- daa welcomed 3.5m million passengers to Dublin Airport in June (up 5.8% on the same period last year).
- On 17 July, An Coimisiún Pleanála released its determination regarding the North Runway Relevant Action, including North Runway's hours of operation, an annual noise quota and annual cap on nighttime movements at the airport, and confirmation of a residential sound insulation grant scheme.
- daa was granted planning permission to proceed with its plans for viewing facilities along the Old Airport Road. The new facility will be free to access and will include an elevated covered platform with seating, a dedicated car park, and lighting powered by solar panels.
- Temporary Noise Monitors: five additional monitors have been delivered and the CLG's nominated locations for two of these monitors is awaited:
