Dublin Airport Update

LOG provided the members with information on flight deviations of North Runway for follow up with airlines	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• We have developed a number of tools over the past two years to increase visibility and understanding of the issue:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ WebTrak now includes an excursion indicator for public viewing○ Detection via ANOMS – surveillance tool to check if aircraft stay within designated Noise Preferential Routes○ Perform Track for four airlines○ Track Performance Reports to 30 airlines
2.	JS requested noise data from portable NMT in Kilreesk	A portable noise monitoring report is due to be published imminently which will provide the relevant data

- Dublin Airport welcomed 2.3m passengers in February, a 9.7% increase year-on-year.
- daa attended a meeting of the Joint Committee on Transport on 24 March to discuss the Dublin Airport (Passenger Capacity) Bill 2026. Resident groups, airlines, business groups and other bodies have also been invited to attend across a number of days in March.
- Fingal Research Report for Winter 2025 is now published on our website. It captures the views and perspectives of Fingal Communities regarding the operations and development of Dublin Airport utilising trend data from across all surveys completed to date.
- The first biannual Instrument Landing System (ILS) testing is taking place this week on four consecutive nights between 11pm and 6am from Monday, 23 March to Thursday, 26 March across the three runways. These checks will be undertaken by a small twin-engine aircraft that will make multiple approaches to each runway at no lower than 100 feet.
