Applications

This notice is to grant a further opportunity for drivers who do not currently operate at Dublin Airport Taxi Rank to submit notices of interest.

- The following form must be completed and submitted from August 15, 2022 – September 4, 2022.
- The permit portal will then open for accepted new drivers to pay from September 5, 2022 and close on September 14, 2022.
- These new driver permits will be granted on a first come, first served basis after NTA Checks are passed.

In order to operate pickups from the Airport Taxi Rank, you will require one of the 2022 Permits which costs €440 for a whole year. The charge you pay will be reflective of a pro-rata charge for the remainder of the permit year, ending May 14, 2023.

Requirements To Operate

As part of the permit application, each permit holder is required to confirm that he/she will comply with the Taxi Operations Manual 2022.

Some of the requirements in this manual include having a:

- Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle
- Licensed to carry 5 passengers
- Operate a card machine for payment

Rebate Scheme for 'Times of Short Supply'

To better serve our passengers, daa's aim is to ensure that identified times of short supply are addressed. To encourage supply during these times, we will be offering a rebate as part of a trial incentive scheme.

Please find the details below:

The cost of a permit breaks down to €8.46 per week. For every week the incentive requirement is met by a Permit Holder, €8.46 will be refunded through a rebate.

- Trips eligible for the rebate will begin from 22:00 on Monday May 16, 2022.
- The incentive scheme will be continuously reviewed and, ideally, extended if working as intended.
- Drivers will be able to collect their rebate payments in the next couple of months, with comms on how to complete this due to be issued in once the system is up and running.
- Any trips completed between May 16 and the date upon which the system goes live will be recorded and will count towards your rebate.
- Dublin Airport will not be able to answer any queries regarding the level of your rebate until the payment system goes live.

Incentive requirement*:

Achieve three points in one week through fare completion to earn the €8.46. rebate*. To achieve a point, you must enter through the Kesh AND pick up a fare through the rank.
